Mission

ISOMA Children's mission is to give the children of the Orkisima village access to free **quality education**. We aim to develop a school programme that integrates disciplinary and environmental studies, physical and artistic education that will enable the **sustainable development of the community.**

Vision

Access to **equal opportunities**, overcoming educational barriers, **preserving Maasai traditions and culture** for an integrated society.



Timeline of Activities

May 2022

ISOMA Children comes into existence with education as its purpose but placing a strong emphasis on The Water Project and recognising the critical significance of water as a fundamental life source. The mission of ISOMA Children revolves around this invaluable resource, with dedicated efforts aimed at ensuring its accessibility and long-term sustainability.

June 2022

A strategic partnership is established with Chem-Chem Drilling to conduct a thorough hydrogeological survey. The survey commences in Orkisima, with the objective of identifying underground water resources that can contribute significantly to the organisation's objectives.

July 2022

Drilling operations begin and reach an impressive depth of 190 meters underground. The purpose is to uncover potential water sources that can be harnessed for the benefit of the communities involved.

August 2022

Even though water has been found 190m underground, the resource is insufficient to supply the children and community. The organisation perseveres in exploring diverse alternatives, actively seeking the most effective strategies to address the urgent needs of the community.

September 2022

In their commitment to finding innovative solutions, ISOMA Children decides to embark on school planning while simultaneously integrating water

captivation systems. This integrated approach ensures a holistic focus on education and water management.

October 2022

ISOMA Children identifies a promising land plot and enters into agreements with the family who owns it. The intention is to acquire a 7.5-acre plot that will serve as the foundation for the organisation's activities.

November 2022

An initial assessment of the selected land plot is conducted, carefully examining its suitability for the planned initiatives.

December 2022 to February 2023

With dedicated determination, the organisation engages in ongoing preparations and fundraising. These efforts are crucial to secure the necessary resources for the successful purchase of the land.

March 2023

Legal agreements with the sellers are finalised, providing the necessary frameworks and support for the charity's endeavours. This ensures a solid foundation for the future initiatives of the organisation.

April 2023

The process of registering the acquired plot with the government of Tanzania commences, demonstrating our commitment to adhering to legal procedures and establishing a presence in the region.



Our plans for 2023-2024

In the coming year, ISOMA Children has set forth several ambitious goals to further its mission and make a positive impact on the Orkisima village. One crucial objective is to **finalise the land registration process** with the government. This step ensures the organisation's legal standing and provides a solid foundation for future endeavours.

Recognising the importance of education, ISOMA Children aims to **conduct a comprehensive census** of the population in Orkisima village. This census will provide valuable insights into the community's growth patterns, enabling the organisation to plan and design the school accordingly. By understanding the anticipated population, ISOMA Children can tailor the school's architecture and facilities to accommodate the future educational needs of the village.

To ensure the successful construction of the school, data collection efforts will be intensified. ISOMA Children will gather relevant information to **inform the architectural design and layout of the school building.** This meticulous approach ensures that the school infrastructure aligns with the specific requirements of the community, fostering an optimal learning environment for the children.

Alongside the construction plans, ISOMA Children aims to break down the costs associated with building the school. **A detailed assessment of expenses** will be conducted, taking into account factors such as materials, labor, and infrastructure requirements. This thorough breakdown will enable the organisation to **budget effectively, seek appropriate funding, and ensure transparency in resource allocation.**

Our plans for 2023-2024

Expanding its reach beyond Tanzania, ISOMA Children has identified the UK market as a valuable platform for raising awareness and garnering support. With this in mind, the organisation will **pursue the registration process as an NGO in the UK.** This strategic move will open up opportunities for partnership, fundraising, and international collaboration to further amplify ISOMA Children's impact.

Lastly, recognising the power of storytelling and visual media, ISOMA Children plans to produce a **short film showcasing the life and culture of the Orkisima village**, highlighting the involvement of ISOMA Children in the community. This film will serve as a powerful tool to raise awareness, inspire empathy, and engage a wider audience, ultimately fostering greater support for the organisation's initiatives.


