

ORKISIMA SUB-VILLAGE WATER MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE AGREEMENT

This document derives from the agreement of the Orkisima sub-village of Lossimingory Village to establish a committee for the management of water resources. This agreement will be carried out by the community of Orkisima with support from ISOMA Children NGO.

Preamble:

ISOMA Children NGO aims to bring access to potable water to the community of Orkisima as a secondary benefit from bringing clean water to the planned school for the children of the community. ISOMA Children has partnered with Chem Chem Drilling to put the necessary infrastructure to access water via a borehole. While ISOMA Children and Chem Chem Drilling intend to enable access to this resource they cannot guarantee potable water will be found or will be accessible.

The Orkisima Sub-village Water Management Committee agrees:

1. The land where the borehole will be established is owned by the community and not by an individual or a family.
2. The water will be designated for the children of ISOMA Children School as a priority and for the community as a second priority.
3. All committee members have listed responsibilities listed below in three categories: **Before Construction; During Construction and After Construction of the borehole.**

RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE WATER MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

1. Obtain legal authority.
2. The community of Orkisima will pay for the drilling permits.-**TZS 300,000**
3. Build a road to ensure the safety of the drilling material and equipment.

4. Inform all members of Orkisima community during public meetings of the objectives of the project, ensuring they understand the responsibilities.
5. Before the drilling commences the community will gather for a prayer in the area.

DURING CONSTRUCTION

1. Work with Chem Chem Drilling supervisor and team members to organise and plan the drilling.
2. While construction material is in the area, the committee will arrange safe storage of equipment, tools, vehicles and materials.
3. Learn how the borehole is build and understand how the system needs to be maintained and fixed when necessary.
4. Educate the community about proper hygiene practices, water use, and how to manage the resource.



AFTER CONSTRUCTION










1. A monetary collection fee will be charged to community members who collect water.
2. The Water Management Committee will be in charge of collecting payments and use the balance for any expenses of running and repairing the water system.
3. Keep proper accounting and evidence of payments and expenses.
4. The fees collected will **solely** be used for routine maintenance and repairs and enhancements to the system.
5. The collection fees will not be used to repair any damages caused by any individual or member of the community.
6. Study and keep a copy of the detailed plans indicating the various pipelines, valves, equipment and other parts of the system.
7. Study and keep manuals for operation and maintenance of the system.
8. Ensure there is not any other construction by any individual or by the community in the future that will affect the system or piping.

9. Ensure no animals damage the system without causing any harm to them.
10. Arrange voluntary labour when necessary for maintenance, repair work and enhancements.
11. Arrange routine cleaning and maintenance of intakes, tanks and pipelines as indicated.
12. Prevent vandalism or damage from individuals, and pay for any repairs caused by such actions.
13. Prevent improper water use.
14. Prevent abuse of water.
15. Protect the borehole and watershed area.
16. Look after and ensure safe storage of tools and spare parts.
17. Continue education for villagers in the maintenance and benefits of the water system.
18. If there are any conflicts or concerns the committee will gather and decide the best course of action together.
19. The Lossimngory chairman and Orkisima sub-village chairman and secretary will attend the meetings and will be informed of all decisions.



